

The conference "Around the Holy Trinity of Halki: Greek Libraries in Constantinople at the time of Patriarch Metrophanes III (16th c.)", to be held in Istanbul on 14-16 October 2015, will be devoted to the constitution or reconstitution of Greek libraries in Constantinople and its region in the first two centuries after the fall of Byzantium.

It will focus on the emblematic case of the library established in the 16th century by the future patriarch Metrophanes III in the Monastery of the Holy Trinity on the island of Halki and marks the completion of the i-Stamboul project dedicated to this library.

The conference will highlight the cultural, material and religious context that allowed at this time the foundation or the reconstruction of new monasteries in the region of Constantinople, and in particular in the Princes Islands, and the constitution of libraries inside these monasteries. Beyond the economic and social issues, it will consider the availability of books and the permanence of Greek culture in the Ottoman capital, as well as representation and imagination of libraries and books. This monastic library, which is intimately related to the patriarchal institution, is also a fertile ground for studying the cultural and religious activity of the Great Church in Constantinople at this time, its relations with the Ottoman rule, but also, more broadly, through the diplomacy of books, the history of religious and cultural exchanges between the Ottoman Empire and Europe.
